## Did You Know


Revelstoke was founded at the "big eddy" on the Columbia River – a spot where people rested during the 1830s on their travels through the Columbia Valley, and the location for which Big Eddy was named!

CARDA — which stands for the Canadian Avalanche Rescue Dog Association — offers training courses and validates dog-handler teams for this important search and rescue role, which Big Eddy has performed for the past six years. It's lots of work for both Bob and Big Eddy. The fall season usually sees them start training in case they're needed to help search an avalanche area — one technique is for Bob to bury several socks in the brush or in snow, with Big Eddy's job to find each of them systematically. It sounds easy, but it's actually quite challenging. Big Eddy works upwind on training, often around distractions such as people looking for buried avalanche beacons, and he has to find all of the socks, not just one of them.

As a sixth-generation working dog, Big Eddy loves the challenge and the snow, but Bob has decided that HCA's pooch has earned a great retirement. be no gold watch, of course, but the rules of a working dog will be seriously relaxed. We predict that Big Eddy will be sleeping on the bed, tracking paw prints through the spring thaw, and generally getting into dog mischief in no time at all. Continuously, he finds all kinds of items with human scent in the bush and bringing them out to Bob — so he continues to be a canine force for cleaning up the environment!

You'll no doubt meet Big Eddy this summer in his new role as "retired and relaxed" greeter of guests — but right now, we'd like to thank everyone who has shared Big Eddy's success as a working dog and enjoyed his company on the helicopters, winter and summer.
