#### Winter Gear Maintenance

It is time to take out all the batteries from avalanche transceivers, headlamps and gps. Give the contacts a clean with a pencil eraser.

Clean the bases of your sliding surface with camping fuel, wipe and do a hot wax. Don't scrape!

Turn down your bindings.

Ensure all buckles on your ski boots are solid.

#### Footwear

The number two question we get is about hiking boots. Sore feet suck. We really like these Trango TRK GTX for both [women](#) and [men](#). They are stable, comfortable, great traction and used happily in all hiking conditions. The most important thing to do when travelling by air to your alpine destination is to wear the hiking boots on your feet while boarding the aircraft. You pull out the Birkenstocks before your seatbelt is secured around your waist! If they lose your luggage, we can outfit you with the other gear and your feet will be happy in your boots! If you plan to purchase a new pair, wear them daily for at least two weeks prior to hiking in them.
